a) JK/SK Policy Review

The Committee agreed that no policy language change will be done at this time, as the Ministry of Education has initiated a review of the student transportation funding formula. The Policy may require changes as a result of the review process.

The audit focused on the controls around the development, review, and communication of administrative procedures relating to bus safety.

The controls evaluated were found to be *Effective* in providing reasonable assurance that bus safety risks are mitigated, and objectives are being met.
